GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. When this application is processed, the previous title will become void. NOTE: Individuals should list their PA Driver's License (PA DL) or Photo ID # in the space provided. Businesses should list their Business ID # (Bus. ID) where indicated (i.e. E.I.N.).
2. If your vehicle was financed when purchased, a lien was recorded against the vehicle. Therefore, your title was originally sent to that lienholder. You are not entitled to possession of the certificate of title until such time as the lien is satisfied. If the lienholder is not in possession of your certificate of title and the lien has been satisfied but not released on PennDOT records, you must have the lienholder complete the information in Section D on the front of this application.
3. If an active lien (recorded less than 6 years prior to the current date or 8 years prior to the current date for a truck tractor or trailer weighing in excess of 10,000 pounds, or 30 years in the case of a mobile home or emergency vehicle) exists on the vehicle record, the owner must contact the lienholder for completion of the satisfaction of lien and lienholder notarization information in Section D. The lienholder's signature must be notarized. NOTE: Section D does not need to be completed if the applicant attaches a lien release letter from the lienholder or the original Pennsylvania Certificate of Title showing the lien has been satisfied.
4. If the title was never received due to loss in the mail, no fee is required if this application is filed within 90 days from date of original issue. For verification purposes, list current mailing address.
5. The vehicle owner(s) or authorized person's signature(s) must be notarized.
6. **Fee: \$22.50.** Do not send cash. Make check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

NOTE: If the vehicle owner is applying for a duplicate title for the purpose of titling the vehicle in another state and is using an out-of-state address, the following documentation must be attached to the request:

- ❖ A copy of the applicant's out-of-state driver's license; and,
- ❖ A copy of a utility bill, bank statement, credit card bill/statement or tax records with the applicant's name and out-of-state address.

PennDOT will issue the duplicate certificate of title and forward the certificate of title to the out-of-state address.
